Parents of students in Grade 8 were invited to attend a Parent Seminar with our School Director, Mr. Neil Smooker to learn more about the High School course selection plan.

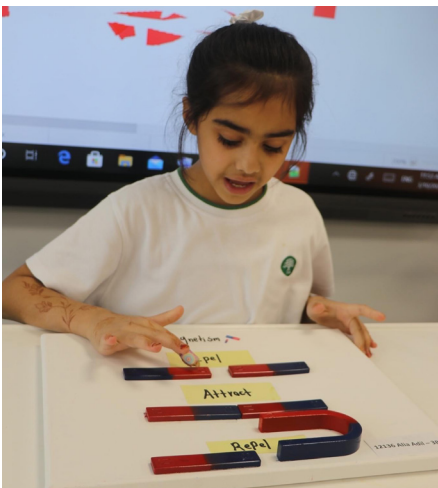
During the seminar, the school presented and explained the educational pathways that will be available for students in High School, and gave parents the information they need to determine the most suitable educational pathway for their children.
