

Senior students visited the Evolve Future Mobility Show, where they explored innovations in transportation and sustainability.




KG PLANTING WEEK

During Planting Week, KG students learned how to care for soil, seeds, and plants in the school garden. The activity supported environmental awareness and hands-on learning.



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


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

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DIRECTOR'S NOTE

Unity Day




KG Red Carpet Day
